

Asthma Nebuliser Information

Asthma Nebulisers

The ship cannot supply asthma nebulisers - you must travel with your own device. If you are bringing an asthma nebuliser on board, you are strongly advised to ensure that your machine is compatible with the ships' power supply by checking with your supplier or service engineer before travelling on the ship. Asthma nebulisers are not available for hire.

Due to the difference in the "Hertz" frequency on the ships, the Ship's Senior Doctor advises that some nebulisers that passengers take on the ship from home do not work on board unless they are of an 'international' type. This is due to the difference in the "Hertz" onboard (as mentioned above). Hertz of the ship is 60HZ.

The International type Nebulisers do work on the ship, however, we still recommend you check the "Hertz" if you are hiring equipment and check the compatibility with the ship's power supply and with the service engineer prior to travel.

Another option would be to use a battery powered nebuliser (not available on board) providing you have enough batteries to cover the duration of the cruise or have a battery charger compatible with the ships power supply (check with supplier or service engineer) to be used with rechargeable batteries. Most mains powered nebulisers operate slower on the ship than on land.

IMPORTANT: Please ensure written details about your medical equipment are forwarded to us prior to travel. On the day of sailing before the ship departs, you are required to get your electrical equipment checked from an Electro-Technical Officer on board, to ensure that the equipment is compatible with the ship's electrical supply and is electrically safe to use.'

Electricity on Pacific Sun, Pacific Dawn and Pacific Jewel

50HZ (Hertz) is the standard electricity frequency in Australia however the ships can only deliver electricity at 60HZ (Hertz). The ships cannot change the frequency of the power supply - Hertz. A transformer only converts electricity to different voltages and will not alter the frequency (Hertz) of the supplied frequency. Most Australian electrical equipment designed to work at 50Hz will either, not work on the ship, or will be damaged if used on the ships.

Pacific Sun have two types of socket in every room. One Australian style socket (220-240v) is located at the dressing table and an American style socket (110v) located in the bathroom for shavers.

Pacific Dawn has the American style sockets (110v) and one Australian style socket (220v). These are located by the dressing table in the cabins.

Pacific Jewel has the American style sockets (110v) and one Australian style sockets (220v). These are located by the dressing table in the cabins.
